### **WGAMI Annual Brunch Meeting**

### **Old Business**

### **New Business**

- There was discussion regarding pull carts after rainy weather and if the course had been declared "cart path only." It was decided that pull carts may be rented from the course or personal pull carts could be used. However, the Pro Shop would charge trail fees in order not to lose revenue. This was agreed on by all present. The "lift, clean, place" rule would be in place at the Pro's discretion. Linda Hawk motioned to agree, and it was accepted by Alice Ernst.
- It was also mentioned that all scoring would be done indoors near or in the dining room so scores could be viewed during the luncheon.,

- Jude also mentioned that CCI would be in impeccable condition due to CCI's Derby event occurring prior to the WGAMI tournament. The greens will be rolled for faster play. Practice rounds will need to be arranged to be played prior to the Derby or on the Sunday before WGAMI.
- Jude also mentioned that Beth Orsay would be appointed to oversee the social media aspect of WGAMI, i.e. Facebook, etc.
- Attendee introductions were made by stating the course each attendee was representing, along with the number of times each individual had played in WGAMI.
- Vicki Bullock and Gina Craig brought up the idea of playing a version of the Solheim Cup format in addition to the individual WGAMI format.
